The Expanding Excellence in England E3 programme is a competitive grant funding scheme designed to support the **strategic growth** of small and excellent research units and departments across England, by **pushing the frontiers of human knowledge** and delivering transformative economic, environmental, and societal impact.

E3 focuses on where distinctive research excellence with the potential for expansion already exists, and where those existing disciplinary or interdisciplinary foci can benefit their local or regional setting at an increased scale. All outputs will contribute towards the delivery of government priorities while maintaining the principles of funding excellence wherever it is found and deliver a research environment that reflects the rich diversity of the UK and cultivates future talent.

LIRCH aims to:

- 1. Create a unique, nationally significant, transdisciplinary research powerhouse to expand excellence and engage with urgent coastal and rural challenges affecting Lincolnshire and beyond.
- 2. Expand and **scale up** the capacity and capability of transdisciplinary **research talent** and **innovation** pathways in the region and beyond.
- 3. **Develop**, **co-design** and **connect** research agenda(s) with regional and national priorities to improve health and wellbeing in coastal and rural communities, **responding** to hidden inequalities and **implementing** and **evaluating** community-based research and interventions.
- 4. Create Future Leaders by **co-creating** our emerging discipline area with a **new generation** of researchers.


